

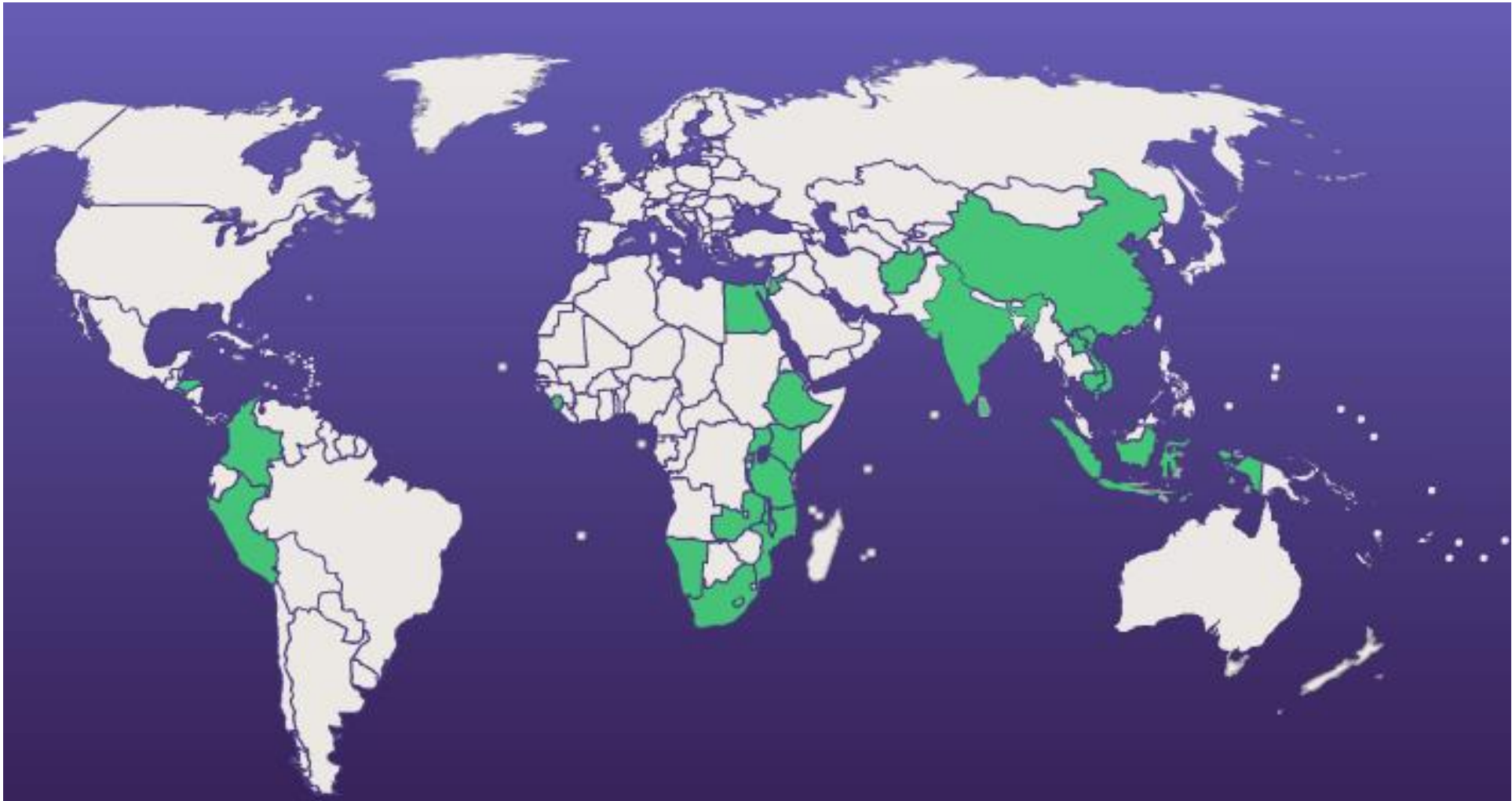

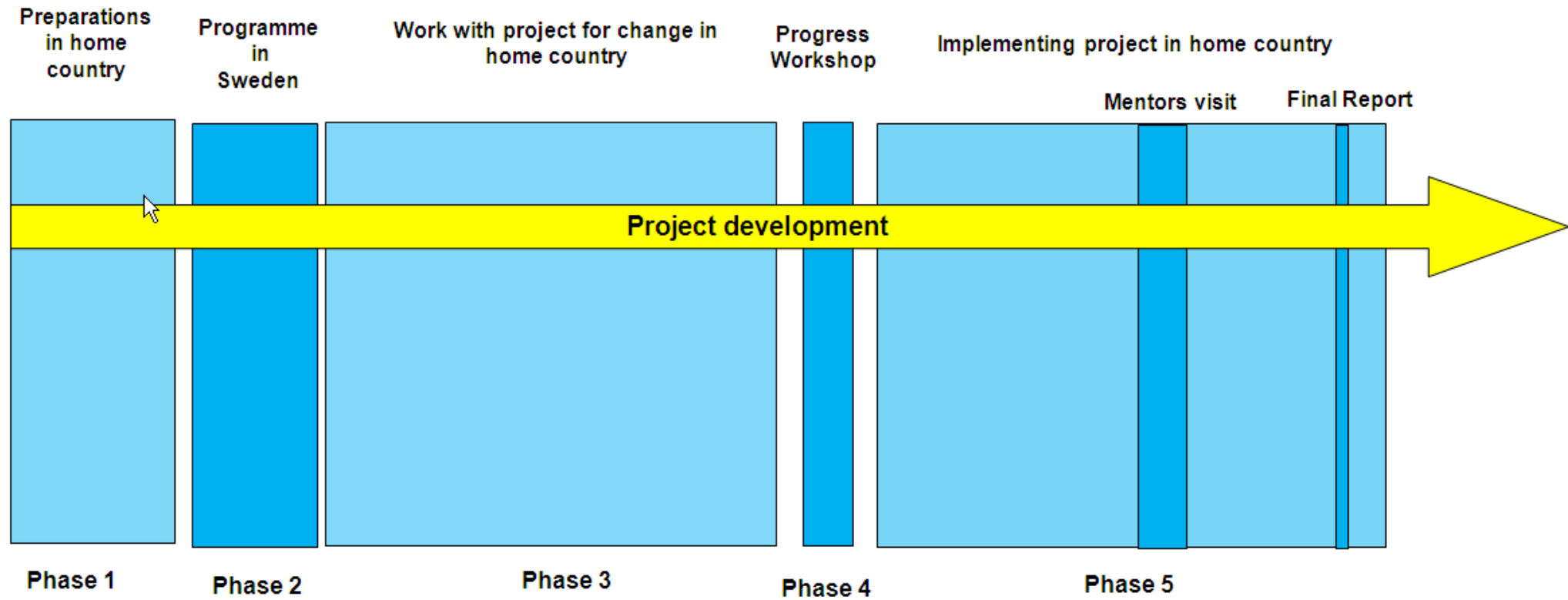

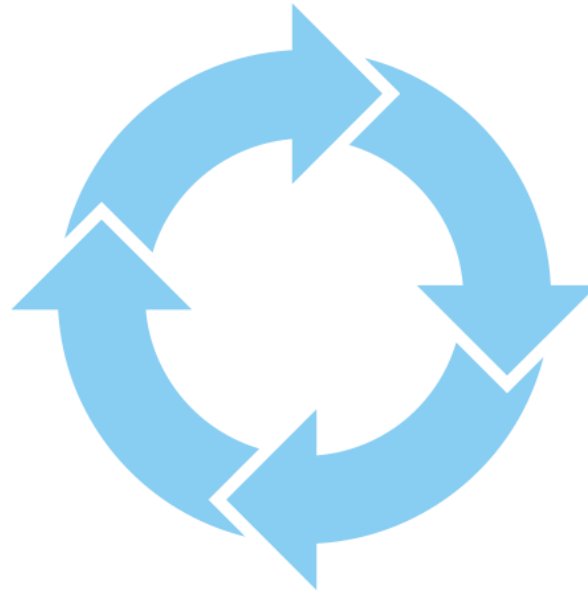
29 countries in 3 continents



1.5 year program for each batch

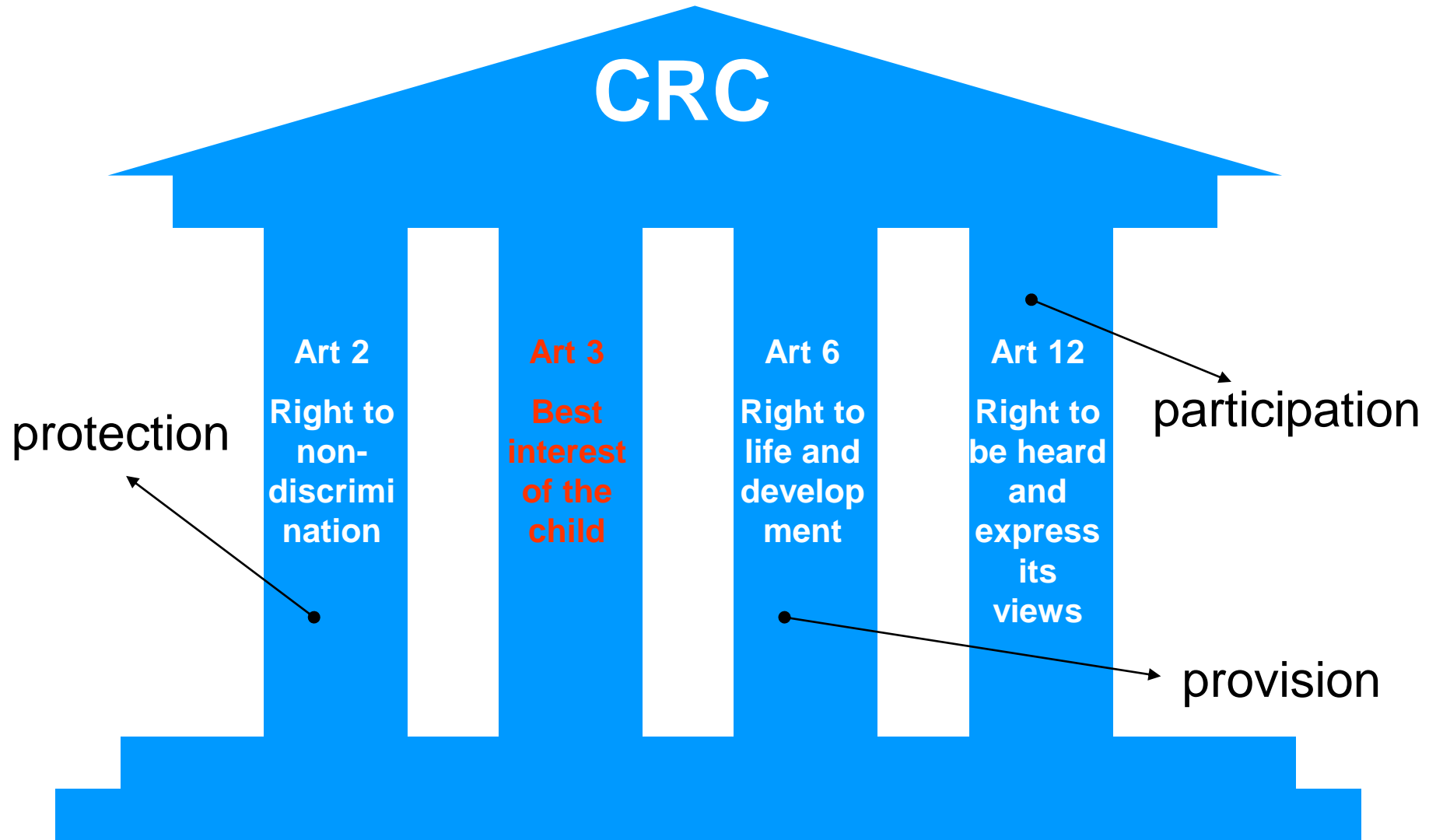

4 basic principles in CRC





UN Child Rights Convention (CRC)

CRC could be described with **3P:s**

P for Provision (food, health care, education, social security)

P for Protection (maltreatment, neglect, all forms of exploitation)

P for Participation (right to act, be involved in decision making)



Visits to other countries during program





Projects included many activities that targeted :

- **Different schools to affect students, teachers, parents , management & school systems**
- **Faculty of Education to affect the culture of future teachers**
- **Ministry of Education officials to affect the curriculum and future content of education system**
- **Civil Society organizations**
