- Based on Preschool Curriculum Framework Focus on L3, and on curriculum in 2nd semester of the school year
- E-lessons broadcast via national TVK-2, private TV and Social Media pages.

- 1. National Radio Episodes on parenting during COVID19 in the form of storytelling
- 2. Provincial radio episodes in MLE for preschool and Grade 1-3, based on curriculum.

Learning assets – MLE Radio episodes for preschool & Grade 1-3 STUDENTS

- Based on school Curriculum, and focus on preschool, and Grade 1-3;
- MLE episodes developed in three languages and broadcast across two provinces;



- Local radio stations engaged in broadcasting;
- Radios distributed to students who do not own one (NGOs);



- Paper-based learning materials distributed to support children learning through radio
- Data collection to measure programme impact ongoing;

Challenges:



- 1. Community concern: some parents worry that children do not learn well via online / distance learning programmes, and just want schools to re-open
- 2. Not enough classroom and teachers
